## Special Board Meeting-Zoom Video Conference **NDPISB**

- 1. Vice-Chairman Randy Ziegler called the Zoom special meeting to order at 10:10 a.m. Board members present: Randy Ziegler, Justin Blinsky, Ernie Thurman, Steven Lundin, and Jason Nelson. Board members absent: Mike Wetsch. Others present: Executive Director John J. Shorey III, Assistant Attorney General Allison Hicks, and Byron Bad Brave.
- 2. Allyson advised Board members they received a packet of information which included a letter from the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), recommended findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order in the matter of the application of Byron Bad Brave. Allyson advised the Board needed to determine whether it wants to adopt the ALJ's recommended findings of facts, conclusions of law, and proposed order; or if they want to make additional findings and modify the findings, conclusions, or order. Byron Bad Brave confirmed it was. Allyson told Byron Bad Brave that he would be receiving a copy of the Board's order via certified mail, so she wanted to confirmed his address was on-file.
